

Responsive design of webpages

Forums – A forum will normally have a section of forums that you can choose the topic that you would like to view. Normally if you're logged into a forum website you're able to start new threads in forums. Other people are able to see your forum if you have set the permission to do so.

Aesthetics – A professional looking website will normally have colours all around the same colours so that there is no colour mismatching. The colours will tend to be bland so that it is suitable for all ages. The colours can play an important role of a website as this can be its main feature. The layout of the website is important to as you don't want all of your text bundled together. You need to look at what looks good and is it readable. You also need to take into consideration of the images to make sure that they're not overlapping and that they're not too opposite in colour. The website can include links to videos (hyperlinks) or it can embed the videos right into the page.

If the website has the same font for all the text on every page on that domain the website is probably using a style sheet. A style sheet in the format or .CSS is the easiest way of keeping things in a style manner and is the easiest way of keeping the colours of the font and the size of the font the same way.

Email links – An email link is normally provided on a website. This can either normally be located at the footer of the page or in the contact page. If you cannot find the email there then there might be an email on the help page or it may tell you where to find one.
